- Revision of Bylaws

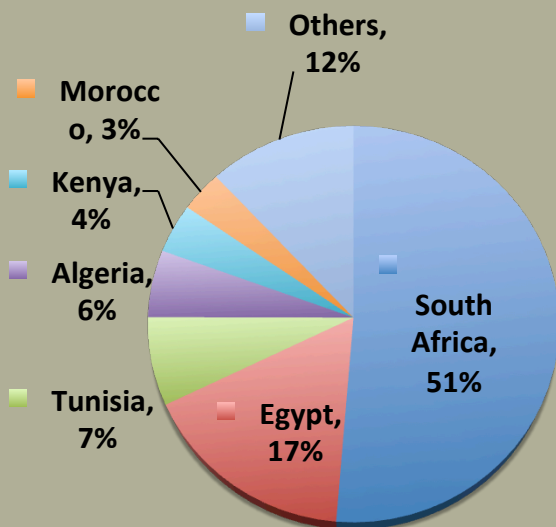

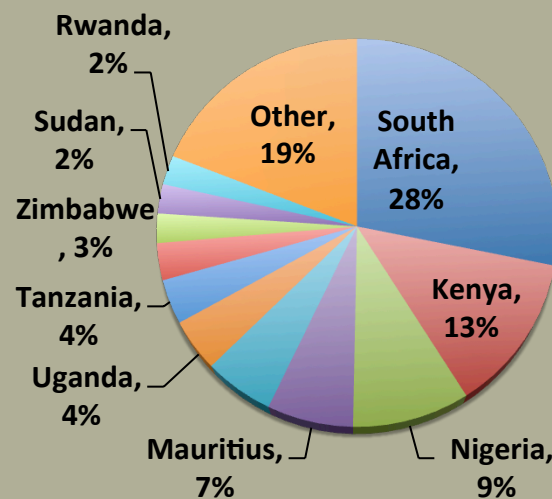

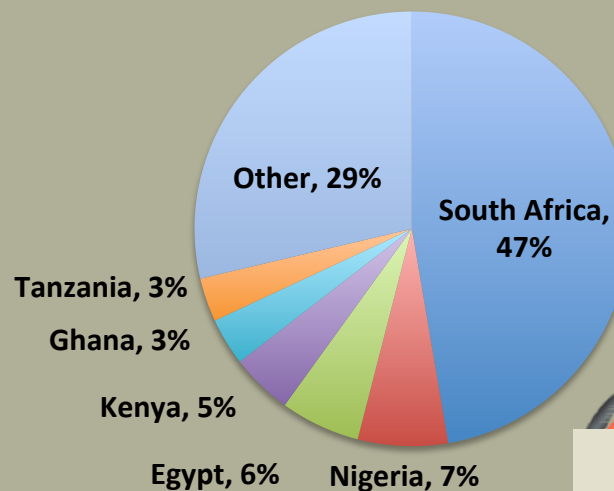
Regional Distribution
