 - Educational or demonstration purposes
- The RIPE NCC request therefor to have a “fake” LIR that mimics the average situation of regular members
- This benefits software development, but also customer services and training

Resource Request

- This “LIR” should have the following resources assigned:
 - /21 IPv4 PA Allocation
 - /32 IPv6 Allocation
 - 1 AS number (32 bit)
- This “LIR” will only exist technically and won't influence the billing algorithm calculation and is not a legal member
- Since this space will not be routed on the internet we can take a block that will be hard to use for others
- These blocks and their use will be documented and clearly marked as such in the RIPE Database
